

Robert Julius 'Bob' Dinkheller, of the Good Samaritan Home, and formerly of 3617 Briarwood, Quincy died Saturday, March 4, 2006 at 10:14 am in Blessing Hospital.

He was born March 13, 1921 in Quincy, Illinois, the son of Julius Fredrick and Josephine Schneider Dinkheller.
